The village – some facts and figures

- Population (2011 census) – 848 – now 880?
- Registered electors (2016) - 726
- Number of dwellings – 379
- Number of second homes (2015) – 37 (9.8%)
- Number of listed buildings – 26 plus telephone kiosk on Stocks Green!
- Number of street lights – 33
- Council tax per household (2016/17 - Band D) - £33.16
- Number of trees protected (TPO) – all trees in Conservation Area plus 13 outside.
- Number of allotments – 29
- 10+ B&B and holiday cottages. 10+ local businesses.
- Land ownership:
 - Holkham Estate owns 732 hectares of agricultural land around the village (see display map) including both Manor and Lodge Farms. Its ownership also extends to the water meadows, the Abbey grounds and part of the village including the East, St James' and Pales Green Greens.
 - CAPC owns Stocks Green and the playing field.
 - NCC own the land directly around the new village school.
 - Green King Breweries owns the land south west of the school
 - Eagle family owns the land between Chimney Street and Blind Lane
 - The Diocese of Norwich owns the small parcel of land off South Acre Road below the churchyard boundary.
