

Examining Molehills in the Priory Field

Sunday 13 February 2022 and Monday 14 February 2022

Led by Heritage Consultant Anne Mason who is also the Project Manager, with guidance from a professional archaeologist.

Over two days of the half term, participants will be able to drop in to the Priory precinct to investigate molehills for archaeological artefacts. They will be taught to record the location of each molehill examined and process, wash and record any artefacts encountered.

Participants will need to wear clothing suitable for this outdoor activity and the weather on the day. Equipment will be supplied. Covid-19 safety measures will apply. It is a legal requirement that all finds are deposited with the Museums Service, Norfolk County Council, together with a report on the investigation.
