The purpose of the Survey

- Risk Assessment; informing residents; dealing with any reluctance/opposition.
- Explaining the Survey Form.
- Guidance on taking photographs.
- What will happen to the results?
- Selection of survey streets/buildings by the volunteers. Volunteers will survey selected streets/buildings and record results on standard survey form.
- Residents will be informed of the survey two weeks beforehand in the Nar Valley News and on the Parish website.
- Volunteers will carry with them an 'open letter' explaining what they are doing and why.
