

Investigating the defences of the Norman planned town and the extent of the medieval town with Test Pits

Saturday 2 July and Sunday 3 July 2022

Castle Acre – gardens and open space around the village - by agreement and with permissions.

Meet at the castle car park at 10.00

Volunteers will be trained to excavate and record archaeological test-pits (following Norfolk County Council's methodology), including the recognition and identification of archaeological deposits and artefacts and the drafting of archaeological reports. It is expected at least five test-pits will be excavated during the three days of fieldwork.

Participants will need to wear clothing suitable for this outdoor activity and the weather on the day. Equipment will be supplied. Covid-19 safety measures will apply.

It is a legal requirement that all finds are deposited with the Museums Service, Norfolk County Council, together with a report on the investigation.
