

Castle Acre Parish News – October/November 2020

The Parish Council (PC) held its usual monthly meeting on Thursday 10 September online by Zoom, with three members of the public in attendance. Given the increase in Covid-19 infections and the restrictions on more than six people gathering indoors, it seems likely that PC meetings will continue by Zoom until the end of the year. New Play area

Following the opening of the highly awaited and much praised new play area, thanks to Castle Acre Playingfield Association (CAPFA), this has inevitably caused a surge of curious visitors to the village. Sadly, some have behaved thoughtlessly by parking on both sides of Massingham Road, causing difficulties for emergency vehicles, and in some instances blocking residents' drives. Thanks to CAPFA for their swift action in putting 'No parking' signs along the playing field fence and for directing vehicles to the St James' Green entrance of the playing field. There were also distressing incidents of people using the field as a toilet. These issues were reviewed at the PC meeting. While accepting that such demand to use the new play equipment will decline in school time and during the winter, visitor parking will be monitored and further restrictions considered. Cllrs asked the Clerk to get quotations for hiring temporary portaloos and to ask CAPFA to look into the feasibility of building a permanent public toilet block onto the side of the pavilion, linked to the drainage there.

RAF Marham – Lightening Force planes night flying notice.

RAF Marham advised the PC that from Tuesday 25th August until Friday 9th October, there will be night flying exercises, predominantly between Mondays to Thursdays. We are assured the loud F-35 planes will return before 2300 each evening, as residents may have already noticed!
